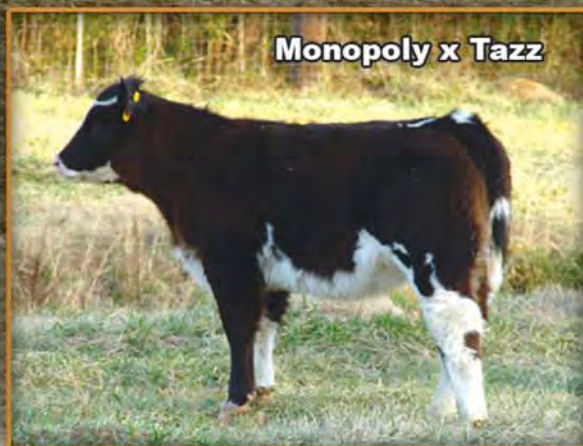

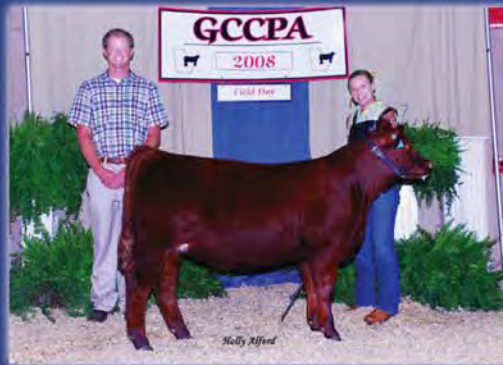

Hanging the banner...

AT ALL COSTS

We at ringside admit what you are about to read won't be popular! It is a topic that most folks would rather avoid and pretend is a non-issue; however, with our passion and our commitment to the industry, we feel it is our obligation to address the following.

Submitted by a great friend of our industry who will be known as an anonymous contributor.

Cheaters in livestock shows?? "Say it Ain't So?"

This popular slogan from the early 20th century was attributed to fan reaction of shoeless Joe Jackson being implicated in the "Black Sox" scandal. For those of you not caught up in the history of America's pastime, Shoeless Joe Jackson was one of the premier baseball players in his era. He helped lead his team, the Chicago White Sox, into the 1919 World Series. He and many of his fellow teammates then made the decision to "throw" the World Series and to lose on purpose, taking cash payments from underworld crime figures in exchange for their "lack of performance." He and his teammates were caught and as a result he was given a lifetime ban from the game of baseball in 1921.

To put that into today's perspective that would be like Tom Brady blowing the Super Bowl on purpose. Joe Jackson was one of the ballgame's premier ball players back in the first score of the 21st century.

Sport Scandals are nothing new. There have been many of them over the years. Why just 20 years ago Pete Rose was banned from baseball from illegally betting on games. So why should we be surprised of the steroid scandal?

The Mitchell Report was released in 2007. The Mitchell Report was a report sanctioned by Bud Selig, Commissioner of Major League Baseball. The key investigator into the perceived steroid use in baseball was former U.S. Senator George Mitchell. His job was a "thankless" one and by most accounts he was used as a figurehead to proclaim the problem that everyone knew was running rampant in Major League Baseball.

--So why did Major League Baseball spend millions of dollars to study a scandal that everyone knew was already present? The answer is money. Millions and millions of dollars were at stake as a result of steroids being present

in the game. The 32 individual owners of major league baseball teams made millions due to the record attendance that accompanied the "juiced" era. From the magical home run record chase of 1998 between Sammy Sosa and Mark McGwire until present, many tickets have been sold to watch professional baseball players hit a little white ball of the fence. It took individual records to get baseball back out of the rut that it created for itself during the last baseball strike that claimed virtually the entire 1994 season. The historic 1998 home run record was the proverbial "fuel the fire," which led to many more major league players experimenting with steroids and HGH (human growth hormone). When the owners realized that they had a huge potential problem on their hand, Senator Mitchell was asked to do a third party investigation... therefore keeping the owners and the MLB players association from taking direct blame for the problem they all watched grow before their very eyes.

Many of you are probably wondering what, if any, correlation the Mitchell Report has in relation to the junior show industry? Well... It kind of goes like this.

I am going out on a limb here and make a statement here that will probably shock you. You might want to put the kids to bed before you utter the words that I am about to write... "There are cheaters in stock shows!" Yes indeed.

I'm sure that statement didn't cause anyone to fall off their chair in shock. We all know that there are cheaters in every aspect of life. There were stock show cheaters back in 1919 (Shoeless Joe Jackson's day) and there are cheaters in stock shows today in 2009.

What would be the ramifications if Senator Mitchell was to do a report on the inner-workings of the junior stock show system? I for one think the report would be HUGE in comparison to the 409 page document he recently delivered to Major League Baseball. Senator Mitchell would find many things wrong with our current system:

1. He would find large numbers of animals being exhibited with incorrect birth dates to be shown in different age categories.
2. He would find many animals being shown by junior exhibitors who did not have "valid" ownership of these animals.

3. He would find many show animals being presented to the judges on show day with high levels of steroids and anti-inflammatory drugs to help the animals gait and soundness levels, or to change touch and handle.
4. He would find many animals whose recorded parentage on purebred registration papers were falsified to allow exhibition of a crossbred in a purebred class, or worse yet, he would find these animals parentage changed to reap a greater selling price.
5. He would find many animals whose phenotype more than expressed its genotype due to both legal/illegal feed additives.
6. He would find many judges making biased judging placements due to relationships/friendships with people exhibiting their animals.

How did these problems get to be as prominent as they appear to be? Well let's start with human nature, greed, big egos and thousands of dollars at stake for championship honors. When you combine mankind's human nature without a typical checks and balance system, abuse is bound to happen. Unfortunately we have very few accurate or affordable tests to reliably determine age, parentage or toxicology. And unless a multi-judge (judge by committee) format is utilized, politics will continue to seep into animal placing

By all accounts, it will be easier in some opinions to clean up organized baseball, than it will be to clean up stock shows. The process of cleaning up the show industry must start from top and filter down.

1. Only judges of impeccable character should be considered to judge these events. Rewarding a judge with questionable past sets a terrible example for our youth and fellow breeders.
2. More shows should reward animal husbandry and showmanship skills as opposed to the judging of individual animals
3. Employees of pedigreed record associations should also be the utmost character and be positive role-models for our youth.
4. Relationships with universities, molecular geneticist and clinical pathologists will aid future findings of affordable assays for detecting illegal

substances in show animals. (This is a terrible waste off their experience as they should be spending their time curing this nation's growing health concerns)

5. Breed registries should be firm in their handlings of disciplinary cases involving malicious cheating to set an example for future cases.
7. Ag Teachers should be working under a "zero tolerance" policy that would prevent them from seeking employment at future schools should they be found to be in violation of ethical guidelines.

We must be role models for the youth of America. These youth projects present the perfect opportunity to train the future leaders of agriculture. The responsibility, discipline, leadership, work ethic, and fiscal planning skills associated with livestock projects are invaluable to a shrinking demographic base such as we find our current agriculture sector. These kids will make lifetime friends as a result of their junior livestock projects, and for many that is the greatest reward for all of their hard work and sacrifice.

Before you bash the Barry Bonds or Roger Clemens of the baseball world for being poor role models, perhaps we should look a lot closer to home at the role models that we are being for our children. It all starts at home. It all starts with you.

Let's vow to make 2009 a year that major cleanup work was completed...not only in major league baseball but also in the national 4-H and FFA programs. Let's try to keep from reading a headline in the newspaper that read's "Joe Blow disqualified for illegal practices at local stock show."

After watching Marion Jones tearful regrets on national television one evening where she admitted not only to illegal substance abuse, but lying about it under oath I could not help but think how she not only hurt herself but her Olympic medal teammates who would be stripped of their medals I had to ask myself was it worth it? Was it worth losing herself in her chase to fulfill her dreams? If she had the choice to make over again what would she do? As the saying goes "Character is what you do when no one else is watching. "We hope these words will stay with you if you are ever confronted with the choice to hang the banner at all cost.

Good Luck and May all your show stock dreams come true this upcoming season!

new owner shall be listed as Breeder
on the GCCPA point sheet.**
- 4. Only dues paying members are eligible
to purchase tags. (Exhibitors can
not pay dues and buy tags for an
individual they purchase the calf from.)**

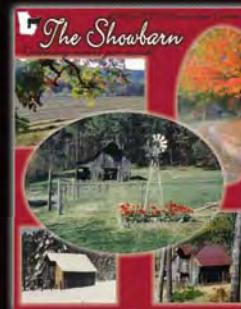
